Rather unclear start, but it settles down and theme at B is pleasantly engaging in its gentle and dance-like musicality.

Slight rushing into E, but once again musical character is well captured.

A - good ensemble in this / cuts. Euph do well into J and good change of mood at J. Lovely solo cut and sensitive duet with euph. Good intimate with euphs up to N and ensuing passage has lots of expressive fluency. P. 17 not quite as convincing, but Q is engaging and rhythmic vitality is pleasing. Slip in 2<sup>nd</sup> of X, but this was a very engaging and musically well characterised performance.
